Your cooperation in following the guidelines will help to make the classes and activities run smoothly and safely! Please read carefully before signing up for classes!



- Participants should be 18 years of age or older.
- Staff and volunteers of the Friends Program cannot give medications to participants.
- Registration and supply fees are required for ALL classes and activities. This includes small group events AND personal write-ins! There are scholarship opportunities available for participants. Please contact the Program Director for more info.
- Due to minimal registration fees, **NO CREDITS WILL BE GIVEN FOR ANY PERSONAL CANCELLATIONS.** Please be courteous to our instructors by calling **605-999-1224 or 605-940-8328** should you need to make a cancellation.
- To ensure proper staffing of classes, the Project Coordinator needs to receive the registration form and fees 5 days prior to the class or activity. Walk-ins are not accepted!!
- Class availability will be on a first come, first-serve basis. Participants will be notified via phone if a chosen class is full. In this case only, the registration fee will be credited for future use. Credits must be used within one year from time of being given.
- If participants choose a class that has a supply fee, please bring the exact payment amount to the class. The instructor may not be able to produce change. When the supply fee includes a pre-purchased ticket, the fee must be paid with a personal cancellation.
- **Transportation to and from all activities is the responsibility of the participant.**
- If a staff, friend, or family member is providing transportation, please escort the participant to the activity. The instructor is there no earlier than 15 minutes before the activity starts. Please return to pick up the participant a few minutes prior to the end of the activity.
- A participant who requires personal assistance must be accompanied and supervised in classes and activities by a staff, friend or family member. Please let us know if there are is any helpful information we ought to be aware of!
- Should a medical emergency arise, FRIENDSLink staff is instructed to call 911.
- In questionable weather conditions, look for cancellations on local radio and television stations, as well as online. Participants will not be called individually. Attempts will be made to reschedule the class and participants will be notified via phone.
