and Obtaining a Controlled Substance  
by Misrepresentation, Fraud, Forgery,  
Deception, and Subterfuge

18 U.S.C. § 1365(a) and 21 U.S.C. §  
843(a)(3)

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT 1

Between on or about July 1, 2022 and December 30, 2022, in Canton, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Brittany Enstad, with reckless disregard for the risk that another person would be placed in danger of death and bodily injury, and under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to such risk, did tamper with a consumer product that affected interstate and foreign commerce, specifically OxyContin, and with the labeling of and container for such a product. Specifically, the Defendant, while working as a registered nurse in a medical facility, tampered with blister packs containing OxyContin by removing the OxyContin and replacing it with other pills, knowing that the other pills could be dispensed to patients at the medical facility, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1365(a).

COUNT 2

Between on or about July 1, 2022 and December 30, 2022, in Canton, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Brittany Enstad, with reckless disregard for the risk that another person would be placed in danger of death and bodily injury, and under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to such risk, did tamper with a consumer product that affected interstate and foreign commerce, specifically Hydrocodone Bitartrate and Acetaminophen, and with the labeling of and container for such a product. Specifically, the Defendant, while working as a registered nurse in a medical facility, tampered with blister packs containing Hydrocodone Bitartrate and Acetaminophen by removing the Hydrocodone Bitartrate and Acetaminophen and replacing it with other pills, knowing that the other pills could be dispensed to patients at the medical facility, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1365(a).

COUNT 3

Between on or about July 1, 2022 and December 30, 2022, in Canton, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Brittany Enstad, with reckless disregard for the risk that another person would be placed in danger of death and bodily injury, and under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to such risk, did tamper with a consumer product that affected interstate and foreign commerce, specifically Oxycodone Hydrochloride, and with the labeling of and container for such a product. Specifically, the Defendant, while working as a registered nurse in a medical facility, tampered with blister packs containing Oxycodone Hydrochloride by removing the Oxycodone Hydrochloride and

replacing it with other pills, knowing that the other pills could be dispensed to patients at the medical facility, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1365(a).

COUNT 4

Between on or about July 1, 2022 and December 30, 2022, in Canton, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Brittany Enstad, with reckless disregard for the risk that another person would be placed in danger of death and bodily injury, and under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to such risk, did tamper with a consumer product that affected interstate and foreign commerce, specifically Oxycodone and Acetaminophen, and with the labeling of and container for such a product. Specifically, the Defendant, while working as a registered nurse in a medical facility, tampered with blister packs containing Oxycodone and Acetaminophen by removing the Oxycodone and Acetaminophen and replacing it with other pills, knowing that the other pills could be dispensed to patients at the medical facility, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1365(a).

COUNT 5

Between on or about July 1, 2022 and December 30, 2022, in Canton, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Brittany Enstad, knowingly and intentionally acquired and obtained OxyContin, a Schedule II controlled substance, by misrepresentation, fraud, forgery, deception, and subterfuge, all in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 843(a)(3).

COUNT 6

Between on or about July 1, 2022 and December 30, 2022, in Canton, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Brittany Enstad, knowingly and intentionally acquired and obtained Hydrocodone Bitartrate and Acetaminophen, a Schedule II controlled substance, by misrepresentation, fraud, forgery, deception, and subterfuge, all in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 843(a)(3).

COUNT 7

Between on or about July 1, 2022 and December 30, 2022, in Canton, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Brittany Enstad, knowingly and intentionally acquired and obtained Oxycodone Hydrochloride, a Schedule II controlled substance, by misrepresentation, fraud, forgery, deception, and subterfuge, all in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 843(a)(3).

COUNT 8

Between on or about July 1, 2022 and December 30, 2022, in Canton, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Brittany Enstad, knowingly and intentionally acquired and obtained Oxycodone and Acetaminophen, a Schedule II controlled substance, by misrepresentation, fraud, forgery, deception, and subterfuge, all in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 843(a)(3).


